

COUNTY OF RENFREW

BY-LAW NUMBER 24-09

**A BY-LAW TO PURCHASE LAND FOR THE
RECONSTRUCTION OF A COUNTY ROAD**

WHEREAS under the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, S.6(1) and S.8, a municipality may pass by-laws to acquire land;

AND WHEREAS under section 5.(3) of the Act, the County of Renfrew's capacity, rights, powers and privileges must be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS under section 31.(6) of the Act, if a municipality acquires land for the purpose of widening a highway, the land acquired forms part of the highway to the extent of the designated widening;

AND WHEREAS the County Operations Committee has reviewed and approved the purchase of the lands described for the purpose of road reconstruction.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the land described as Part Lot 27, Con. B EML, geographic Township of Westmeath, in the Township of Whitewater Region, described as Part 1 on Plan 49R-16870 be purchased from Neil Thrasher for the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
2. That the land described as Part Lot 26, Con. B EML, geographic Township of Westmeath, in the Township of Whitewater Region, described as Part 2 on Plan 49R-16870 be purchased from Wayne Whitmore for the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00).
3. That the land described as Part Lot 26, Con. B EML, geographic Township of Westmeath, in the Township of Whitewater Region, described as Part 3 on Plan 49R-16870 be purchased from Hayway Farms for the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00).
4. That the land described as Part Lot 25, Con. A EML, geographic Township of Westmeath, in the Township of Whitewater Region, described as Part 4 on Plan 49R-16870 be purchased from Greg Kenny for the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
5. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

READ a first time this 26th day of February, 2009.

READ a second time this 26th day of February, 2009.

READ a third time and finally passed this 26th day of February, 2009.
