BY-LAW NUMBER 20-10

**A BY-LAW TO PURCHASE LAND FOR THE
RECONSTRUCTION OF COUNTY ROAD 63**

WHEREAS under the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, S.6(1) and S.8, a municipality may pass by-laws to acquire land;

AND WHEREAS under section 5.(3) of the Act, the County of Renfrew's capacity, rights, powers and privileges must be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS under section 31.(6) of the Act, if a municipality acquires land for the purpose of widening a highway, the land acquired forms part of the highway to the extent of the designated widening;

AND WHEREAS the County Operations Committee has reviewed and approved the purchase of the land described for the purpose of road reconstruction.

THEREFORE the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the County of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the land located on County Road 63, described as Part Lot 10, Concession 7, geographic Township of McNab, in the Township of McNab/Braeside, described as PARTS 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 14, 15, 16 & 19 on Reference Plan 49R-17210, be purchased from John McKelvie Kidd for the sum of two dollars (\$2).
2. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

READ a first time this 25th day of February, 2010.

READ a second time this 25th day of February, 2010.

READ a third time and finally passed this 25th day of February, 2010.
