### Highlights

- Mr. Bob Schreder of the Renfrew County & District Health Unit presented an overview of changes to the inspection process and new regulations in reference to wells. Mr. Schreder gave an in-depth presentation on specific changes to Risk Assessment for over 700 Small Drinking Water systems in the county.
- Mr. Dave Darch, Director of Public Works & Engineering, updated Council on the Capital Works Projects to be submitted under Round Two of the Building Canada Fund and the Infrastructure Stimulus Fund. Three county roads and the Centennial Lake Bridge will be submitted for the cost-sharing programs.
- County Council formally adopted the County of Renfrew 2009 Business Plan. The 2009 Business Plan can be accessed on the official County of Renfrew Website.

## Council Initiatives

- County Council passed a resolution for the rehabilitation of the Douglas Bridge located in Admaston/Bromley Township. The bridge will remain open during the rehabilitation, but will be reduced to single-lane traffic.
- County Council passed a resolution that establishes the new Child Care policies within the County of Renfrew. Some of the changes within the new policies reflect the evolutionary changes that have occurred in the delivery of child care services in the last ten years within the Social Services Department of the County of Renfrew..
- County Council passed a resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Eastern Ontario Development Fund in the amount of \$162,500. The grant is designed to help create a unified County of Renfrew Trails Network as outlined in the 2007 County of Renfrew Trails Strategy.
