## Council Initiatives

- In 2008, the County Renfrew hosted an emergency exercise “Flu the Coop”. This was an Emergency Management Program where a multi-municipality Emergency Exercise was developed. An invitation has been extended to all local municipalities and we hope to see all 17 municipalities take part in a similar exercise.
- The Ontario Forest Industries Association (OFIA) presented two awards for remarkable contribution and leadership in the forest industry. Mr. Dana Shaw, Executive Director, OFIA, presented these awards to the County of Renfrew and Mr. Jeff Muzzi, Manager of Forestry Services. These awards are presented to individuals and communities who are dedicated to promoting the sustainable use of Ontario’s forests.
- County Council passed and approved the 2011 Business Plan/ Budget. The impact after considering the increased levy of 0.5%, the impact of Current Value Assessment Growth of 1.6% and the valuation change increase of 6.64%, is a County tax rate **decrease** of 7.13% in 2011.
