## Council Initiatives

- County Council was informed that 2013 marks the 25th Anniversary of Enterprise Renfrew County. It originally began as the Renfrew Business Self-Help Office in the Town of Renfrew. A satellite office opened in the County Administration Building in Pembroke, and in 2002, both offices officially became known as Enterprise Renfrew County.
- County Council agreed to host water gauges on County property to assist in the monitoring of ground water levels as opposed to surface water levels. This will help the Water Response Team develop strategies in the event there are similar low water conditions as experienced in the County of Renfrew in 2012.
- Madawaska Valley Mayor David Shulist posed with Warden Peter Emon, Killaloe, Haggarty & Richards Mayor Janice Visneskie, Renfrew Reeve Audrey Green and County Executive Assistant Rosalyn Gruntz with the Heritage Cup.
