- Ms. Kim Blackmore, a Registered Nurse with the Renfrew County & District Health Unit, appeared before County Council to provide an update on the H1N1 Virus at both the county and provincial level.

## Council Initiatives

- County Council passed a resolution that called for a letter of invitation to be sent to the Honourable Lisa Raitt, Minister of Natural Resources, to appear before County Council following the tabling of a report on the current and future status of Atomic Energy of Canada Limited, Chalk River Laboratories.
- County Council passed a resolution that supports the efforts of the Pontiac-Renfrew Transport Group to establish a railway line that would service both Renfrew County and Pontiac County. The resolution did not offer any monetary support to the project.
- County Council passed a By-law authorizing the Warden and Clerk to Enter into a Contract/Agreement with Child Care Providers for the Purpose of Child Care Services within the County of Renfrew.
