Council Communiqué

Council Initiatives

- Council passed a By-law updating the County of Renfrew User Fee By-law and Schedule. Section 391 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 allows municipalities to impose fees or charges on any class of persons for municipal services, costs payable by the municipality for services undertaken by another municipality, and for the use of municipal property. Accordingly, an annual review of the County of Renfrew User Fees was completed and changes to the previous User Fee Schedule were approved.
- County Council passed a resolution supporting (in principle) a submission of the Ontario Power Authority Feed-in Tariff Program (FIT) Application to the Ontario Government for a 190 kW Photovoltaic Project at the Bonnechere Manor, 470 Albert Street, Renfrew, Ontario.
- County Council approved the Terms of Settlement between Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local 4698, Paramedic Service and the Corporation of the County of Renfrew for the period from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2013; and subject to ratification by both parties, that a By-law to authorize the Warden and Clerk to execute an Agreement between (CUPE) 4698, Paramedic Service and County of Renfrew be adopted at the next session of County Council.
