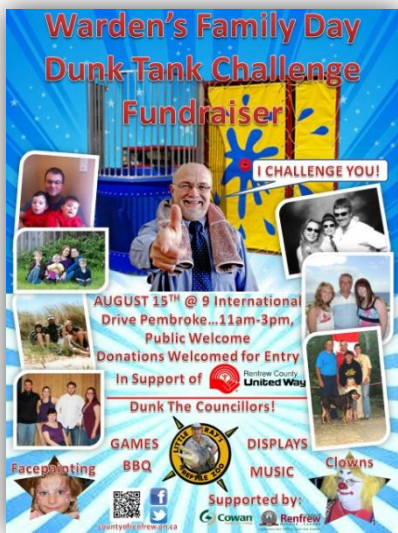


HIGHLIGHTS
