

County Council Appoints Two Deputy Wardens

At the February session of County Council, Councillor Kim Love from Madawaska Valley Township and Councillor Janice Visneskie Moore from Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards Township were appointed as Deputy Wardens to assist Warden Jennifer Murphy with regards to attending Canada 150 Events and celebrations throughout the County this year.
