Mr. Chris Hinsperger, Chair of the Ottawa Valley Tourist Association (OVTA) appeared as a delegation before County Council to deliver the 2018 OVTA budget and annual report. Mr. Hinsperger reviewed the activities and promotional efforts of the

OVTA in 2017, which included tradeshows, media exposure, publications. He highlighted the visitor numbers from 2017. Specifically, there were nearly 1.6 million visitors that spent over \$165 million during their visits. Mr. Hinsperger laid out the plan for 2018, which includes a look at cycling routes and destinations.

County Council Adopted By-Law 9-18 A By-Law to Authorize the County of Renfrew Ontario Works to Enter into a One-Year Renewal Memorandum of Understanding Agreement with the United Way Simcoe Muskoka for the Delivery of the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program.
