Highlights

- Michael Nolan, Director of Emergency Services, along with Renfrew Paramedic Base District Manager Rick Rogers and Acting-District Manager Steve Osipenko, presented a cheque in the amount of \$652 to Robyn Arsenault for the Bonnechere Manor Auditorium Fund. The money was raised at the First Annual Renfrew Rib Challenge. Mr. Rogers won the competition. - Council passed a resolution for a Pedestrian Crossing Policy as it pertains to pedestrian crossings or crosswalks on County of Renfrew roadways. The purpose of the by-law is to meet the needs of the County of Renfrew while providing for safe pedestrian crossings on county roads.
- County Council passed a resolution directing staff of the Development and Property Department to proceed with the establishment and issuance of a Request for Proposal for the construction of a 3,200 square foot Auditorium addition to the south side of the existing Bonnechere Manor.
