County Council Stands Up Against Violence

At the May session of County Council, a delegation from Bernadette McCann House appeared in chambers to ask for the support of councilors in their 'Stand Up Against Violence' campaign. The campaign was brought to chambers by Councillor Kim Love, and she gave a brief introduction of the initiative and then asked Council and staff to join together for a group photo in support of the initiative.



The campaign encourages the community to participate in the Stand Up Against Violence photo campaign challenge. Community members can have their photo taken by an agency representative and pictures have appeared on the website, Facebook and with several media outlets. In addition, individuals and groups have made their own signs and sent "selfies" to the agency. Bernadette McCann House says that more than 500 people from across Renfrew County have participated, including families, sports teams, businesses, non-profits, health professionals and churches. Their goal is to reach 1,000 people photographed in support of the campaign. Erin Norris, a volunteer and Public Education Coordinator at Bernadette McCann House says, "If you believe violence is not acceptable in our community, please stand up."
