### MIRAMICHI LODGE RECEIVES AWARD

At the May session of County Council Miramichi Lodge was celebrated for its recent award from Accreditation Canada. They recently advised that: Miramichi Lodge has again been awarded their highest standing - “**Accredited with Exemplary Standing**”; “Miramichi Lodge has gone beyond the requirements of the accreditation program and demonstrates excellence in quality improvement”. Accreditation Canada sets national standards and shares international leading practices to facilitate continuous quality improvement. Of the 448 quality standards applicable to long-term care; Miramichi Lodge met 100% of the standards. Warden Jennifer Murphy said that this achievement demonstrates the organization’s commitment to ongoing quality improvement. In a recent comment, Mayor Janice Visneskie Moore, Chair of the Health Committee, said that with each accreditation cycle, the quality improvement bar continues to be raised in line with our culture of continuous quality improvement and added
