HIGHLIGHTS

Warden Peter Emon recognized the out-going 12 County Councillors with a presentation highlighting their contributions over their years of service on County Council. Both the Warden and County of Renfrew CAO Jim Hutton commended the councillors on their dedication and efforts in making "Renfrew County one of the best municipalities in Ontario."

Representatives of the Renfrew County Road Supervisors Association (RCRSA) made a donation to both the Miramichi Lodge and Bonnechere Manor Foundations, with each foundation receiving \$2,500. In addition the RCRSA announced their scholarship and bursaries contributions to 11 high schools across the county in the amount of \$30,000, and a further \$10,000 to be split between each of the 5 Hospitals in the county. Also receiving support were the Renfrew County Food For Learning Student Nutrition Program and the RCRSA Training Fund. In total the RCRSA distributed \$55,500 into the community from the proceeds of the 2014 Association of Road Supervisors Trade Show held this past June in Arnprior.

Warden Peter Emon presented this year's *Warden's Community Service Awards* at Wednesday's session of County Council. The three recipients were: The Deep River Hospital Ladies Auxiliary was honoured as the not-for-profit, Sullivan and Sons was honoured as the recipient of the business category, and Mr. Darrel Ryan was honoured with the individual award. The Warden's Community Service Awards recognize and promote the outstanding efforts by community champions in Renfrew County for their active roles with social responsibility and community contributions. Each year, nominees are considered in each of the three categories on the basis of criteria as to how they contribute to the County of Renfrew's Quality of life.

CAO Jim Hutton, presented the 2014 Wellness Challenge Cup to this year's winning team, Public Works and Engineering. The PW&E staff were commended on their 92% departmental participation in Healthy Workplace Month. As part of the Healthy Workplace Month staff raised funds for the local chapter of the Canadian Tire Jump Start Program. County staff presented a cheque to the charity in the amount of \$1,148.10.
