EDMUND HEAD.

JOHN A. MACDONALD, VICTORIA, by the Grace of Atty. Genl. God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c., &c., &c.

To all to whom these presents shall come or whom the same may concern—GREETING:

WHEREAS in and by an Act of the Legislature of this Province, made and passed in the Twenty-fourth year of Our Reign, intituled: "An Act to provide for the separation of the County of Renfrew from the County of Lanark," it is amongst other things enacted, that "the Reeves and Deputy Reeves of the several Townships and other Municipalities in the County of Renfrew, shall form a Provisional Municipal Council for the said county, and shall, with respect to the said County, have, possess and exercise all and singular the rights, powers, privileges and duties conferred, granted or imposed by the Laws of this Province upon Provisional Municipal Councils constituted by Proclamation, under the authority of chapter Fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada; and Our Governor in Council shall issue a Proclamation appointing a time and place for the first meeting of the said Provisional Council, and therein name one of its

Members to preside at the Meeting." Now KNOW YE, that by virtue of the powers conferred in and by the above Act, and in pur-

suance of any other power in this behalf, Us enabling, We do by this Our Royal Proclamation, appoint THURS-DAY, the TWENTIETH day of JUNE instant, as the time, and the Village of Renfrew, in the County of Renfrew, as the place for the first meeting of the Provisional Municipal Council of the County of Renfrew, and that Thomas Patrick French, Esquire, one of the Members of the said Provisional Municipal Council, shall preside at the meeting thereof; Of all which Our loving subjects and all others whom these presents may concert, are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of Our said Province of Canada to be hereunto affixed: WITNESS, Our right Trusty and Well-Beloved the Right Honorable Sir EDMUND WALKER HEAD, Baronet, K. C. B., one of Our Most Honorable Privy Council, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governer in Chief in an over Our Provinces of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and the Island of Prince Edward and Vice Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c. At Our Government House, at Our CITY of QUEBEC, in Our said Province, this SIXTH day of JUNE, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, and in the Twenty-fourth year of Our Reign.
