



## Notice of Completion of Phase 1 and 2 Study Report Petawawa Transportation Planning Study

The County of Renfrew, in cooperation with the Town of Petawawa and Canadian Forces Base (CFB) Petawawa, has completed a Phase 1 and 2 Study Report, which examined the short term and longer term improvements required to the Petawawa transportation system, to support growth at CFB Petawawa (Base) and in the community. The study recommended the construction of a new route, which will necessitate completion of Phases 3 and 4 of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* process. Two alternatives for a new route were identified:

- Connection between Laurentian Drive and Ypres Boulevard
- Connection between Paquette Road and Murphy Road west of downtown

Consultation during Phases 1 and 2 included a Public Information Centre and presentations to the County of Renfrew Operations Committee and to the Town of Petawawa Council and Base representatives. Additional consultation will be included in Phases 3 and 4.

A Phase 1 and 2 Study Report has been prepared. It describes the purpose, need, alternative solutions, evaluation and preferred solutions for the study. Copies of the Phase 1 and 2 Study Report are available for a 30 day public review period at the following locations:
