Sections of the road provide inadequate stopping sight distance, and are deficient in both horizontal and vertical alignment. Improvements are required to address an inadequate platform width, improper intersection alignments and drainage problems within the right-of-way. Additional property may be required in order to construct the road to meet current design standards.
