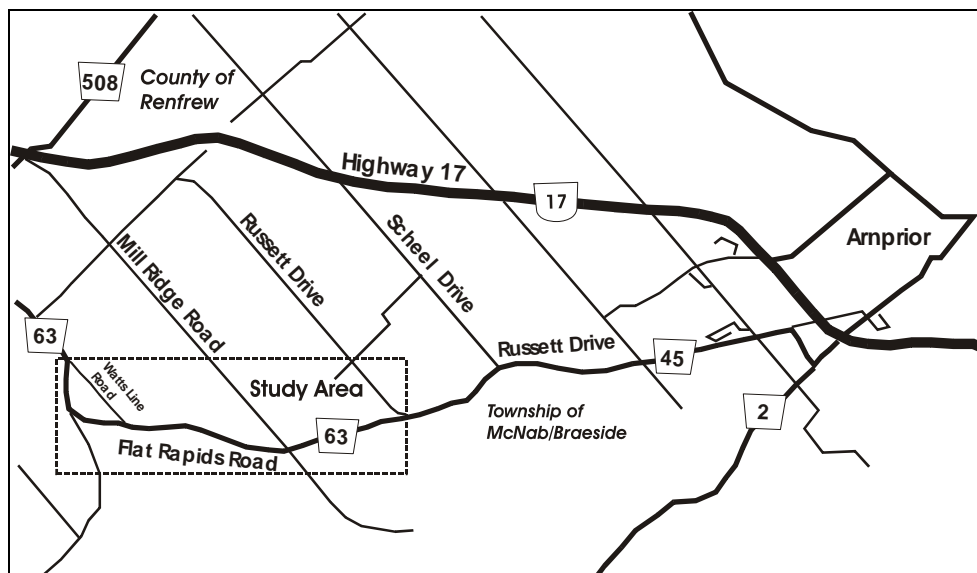

The County of Renfrew is continuing its Class Environmental Assessment for County Road 63 (Flat Rapids Road) from Russett Drive to Stewartville Road. The purpose of this study is to examine this section of County Road 63, which is currently in poor condition and in immediate need of rehabilitation and/or reconstruction.

There are numerous geometric design deficiencies including sections of the roadway, which provide inadequate stopping sight distance and are deficient in both horizontal and vertical curvature. Improvements are also required to address inadequate platform width, improper intersection alignments, drainage problems within the right-of-way and the road. The study will identify the roadway solution that best addresses these safety and operational related concerns while minimizing impacts to the natural and socio-economic environment.

The project is being planned as a Schedule 'C' project under the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (2000) document. The EA Study will confirm project need and justification, document existing environmental conditions, examine alternatives and potential impacts, and recommend mitigation measures.



There is an opportunity at any time during the EA process for interested persons to provide comments. Any information or comments received pertaining to this Environmental Assessment study (including your name and address), form part of the public record and may be disclosed/made available by the County to such persons as the County sees fit, including anyone requesting such information. Accordingly, in providing any such information, you shall be deemed to have consented to its use and disclosure as part of this planning process.

An original Public Open House was held on January 30, 2007, which allowed the public to review and discuss background information, roadway options and future consultation for the project with County of Renfrew representatives.

This purpose of the second open house will be to present and obtain public input on the following:

- Environmental assessment process;
- Draft Study Outline Report;
- Existing conditions;
- Review preliminary roadway alternatives;
- Study Schedule; and
- Receive public comments.

At the completion of the study, an Environmental Study Report documenting the effects anticipated by the project and the corresponding mitigation measures will be prepared and placed on the public record for public and agency review.
