

**COUNTY OF RENFREW**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 7-99**

**A BY-LAW TO ENTER INTO LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
COUNTY OF RENFREW AND THE VILLAGE OF KILLALOE**

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended, Section 191, authorizes the Council of every Municipal Corporation to pass by-laws for the purpose of leasing property;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable that the County of Renfrew enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Village of Killaloe.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Memorandum of Agreement marked as Schedule "1" attached to and made part of this by-law shall constitute an agreement between the Corporation of the County of Renfrew (Lessee) and the Village of Killaloe (Lessor).
2. That the Warden and Clerk are hereby empowered to do and execute all things papers, and documents necessary to the execution of this by-law.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the passing thereof.

**READ** a second time this 27th day of January, 1999

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 27th day of January, 1999
