BY-LAW NUMBER 6-07

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE SPEED LIMITS
ON A TEMPORARY BASIS**

WHEREAS Subsection (2) and (3) of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality and the trustees of a police village by by-law to prescribe a rate of speed of 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90 or 100 kilometres per hour for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of highway under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS Subsection (6) of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality by by-law to prescribe a lower rate of speed for motor vehicles passing over a bridge on a highway under its jurisdiction that is prescribed in subsection (1) or in a by-law passed under subsection (2), but the lower rate of speed shall not be less than 10 kilometres per hour and signs indicating the maximum rate of speed shall be posted in a conspicuous place at each approach to the bridge;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed limit for motor vehicles passing over the Latchford Bridge, Structure #B233, in the Township of Brudenell, Lyndoch & Raglan in the County of Renfrew, be decreased.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew enacts as follows:

1. That the speed limit for motor vehicles passing over the Latchford Bridge be reduced to 40 kilometres per hour and that signs be posted in a conspicuous place at each approach to this bridge identifying the newly posted speed limit.
2. That the penalties provided in Subsection (14) of Section 128 of The Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
3. That this by-law shall have full force and effect from the date the portion of Highway as described above is marked out in accordance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, and shall remain in force until it is reinstated to its former speed limit, by by-law, by the Director of Public Works & Engineering.

READ a first time this 31st day of January 2007.

READ a second time this 31st day of January 2007.

READ a third time and finally passed this 31st day of January 2007.
