

**COUNTY OF RENFREW**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 68-08**

**A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH ROADWAY SERVICE STANDARDS  
FOR THE MUNICIPAL ROAD SYSTEM WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF  
THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF RENFREW**

WHEREAS Section 44 of The Municipal Act, 2001 requires a municipality that has jurisdiction over a highway or bridge to keep it in a state of repair that is reasonable in the circumstances;

AND WHEREAS The Municipal Corporation of the County of Renfrew is a municipality that has jurisdiction over highways and bridges;

AND WHEREAS Ontario Regulation 239/02 as amended sets out the Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew hereby enacts:

1. That all operational services of the Public Works & Engineering Department be directed to provide services, where applicable, that meet the Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways as established by Ontario Regulation 239/02 as amended.
2. That where a situation arises or applications are made which fall outside the scope of these standards, the Director of Public Works & Engineering shall respond as he/she deems appropriate, with due regard to budgetary constraint and reasonable practice.
3. That By-Law 65-02 being A By-Law to Establish Roadway Service Standards for the County Road System, is hereby repealed.
4. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the passing thereof.

**READ** a second time this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2008.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2008.
