**Revisions and Addenda to Environmental Study Report**  
**Notice of Filing of Addendum**

The County of Renfrew retained AECOM Canada Ltd. in August 2020 to complete the transportation study and detailed design of County Road 51 (Petawawa Boulevard) intersections from County Road 26 (Doran Road), northerly 1.2 km to Garrison Petawawa, Town of Petawawa, Ontario.

**Revisions and Addenda to Environmental Study Report**

In 2014, the County of Renfrew completed a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for improvements to the Transportation Network in the Town of Petawawa and documented the process in the *Petawawa Transportation Study Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study Phase 3 and 4 Environmental Study Report* (AECOM, 2014). The key map from this study is provided for reference.



With the transfer of the Ottawa Valley Railway to the County of Renfrew after the completion of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment study, a trail was established. The trail crosses Doran Road just west of Petawawa Boulevard. The County ownership of this former rail right-of-way allowed reconsideration of the intersection traffic control. As a result, it is proposed to construct a roundabout at the intersection of Petawawa Boulevard and Doran Road-Mohns Avenue rather than maintain the traffic control signals at this intersection. The roundabout is expected to improve operations and safety for vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists and trail users.

An Addendum to the Environmental Study Report has now been completed and issued on November 4, 2021 for a 30-day review period. The Addendum contains details of the revised roadworks. Please note that only the changes proposed in the Addendum are open for review.

By this Notice, the Addendum is being placed on the public record for review in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended 2007, 2011 & 2015). Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, the County of Renfrew intends to proceed with the construction of this project as soon as funds are available.

In addition, a request may be made to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks for an order requiring a higher level of study (that is, requiring an individual / comprehensive environmental assessment approval before being able to proceed), or that conditions be imposed (such as require further studies), only on the grounds that the requested order may prevent, mitigate or remedy adverse impacts on constitutionally protected Aboriginal and treaty rights. Requests on other grounds will not be considered. Requests should include the requester's contact information and full name for the ministry.

Requests should specify what kind of order is being requested (request for additional conditions or a request for an individual/comprehensive environmental assessment), how an order may prevent, mitigate or remedy those potential adverse impacts, and any information in support of the statements made in the request. This will help ensure that the ministry is able to efficiently begin reviewing the request.
