Rehabilitation of County Structure B007 (Butler Bridge)

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

May 2024

The County of Renfrew hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* (CNWA) for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of CNWA, the County of Renfrew has deposited with the Minister of Transport, via the on-line Navigable Waters Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>), under the NPP file number 2024-412510, a description of the following works and its site and plans:

Butler Bridge is located on Butler Road, approximately 1 km south of Hwy 60, and spans the Bonnechere River. The County of Renfrew has identified that Butler Bridge requires rehabilitation which will include removal and replacement of the expansion joints, removal and replacement of the concrete deck overlay, waterproofing, reconstruction of the concrete parapet walls, approach slab reconstruction and repairs to the ends of the concrete girders. The bridge and approach roadway will receive new asphalt paving. The guide rail on the approaches will be replaced and the existing barriers will be removed and replaced. The work will be focused to the topside of the bridge and no obstructions which would prevent navigation are expected. Advanced navigational warning signage will be placed upstream and downstream of the bridge. Construction is anticipated to occur between May and November 2024.

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
